Functions in the Llyn Gwynant Barns: Information sheet

The beautiful situation and privacy of the barns and barn fields at Llyn Gwynant makes them a wonderful venue for functions such as weddings and birthdays. You can organize your own functions and can combine camping with your event using the two nearby fields which are separate from the public campsite: Barn field is suited for camping but also for marquees and for parking at large events, while Cae hendre (hollow field) is a lovely rolling meadow for camping which also has a fire site and overlooks the lake. Both fields open off the barnyard which is surrounded by hedgerows.

Facilities: All barns have electricity. The **Camping barn** has hot water, gas stove and hobs, large fridge/freezer and washing up area, with wooden tables and benches in the kitchen, a wood burning potbelly stove and seating area as well as a phone; Adjoining this is **Tall barn** with sleeping platforms. The **Function barn** is a large space with electric lights and power points, huge oak-framed windows, a stone fireplace and a stage at one end. This room can hold 300 people or seat 150 at tables. The **barnyard** outside is for parking and has a toilet porta-cabin with 1 ladies and 2 gents toilets as well as 2 urinals. Extra portaloos can be provided. We can hire equipment including a music / p.a. system, tables and chairs for 150 people as well as some cookware.

Conditions apply: See our **Terms and Conditions sheet** for full details.

- Only acoustic music is allowed outside and only during the day. Sound systems must be barely audible on the campsite after 11.30 pm, inaudible after 1.00 am. A noise bond may be required.
- Fires are permitted either on steel firepits that we provide or on the fire site in Cae Hendre field. Wood must be purchased from the campsite at £4 per bag, unless otherwise arranged.
- Small groups using only the camping barn use only the Barn field and must keep vehicles in the yard. For large functions both fields are available and parking may be in Barn field.
- Barns and fields must be left tidy, with rubbish in the bins provided, glass and cans separated for recycling. A service bond of £200 for the Function barn is refunded if all conditions are met.
- Maximum number of people for a function is 400. Up to 150 can be seated at tables.
- Arrive after 2.00 pm, and leave by 11.00 am unless otherwise arranged.

Event license: you need a Temporary Event License from Gwynedd Council if you are selling alcohol at your function, and note that this takes at least 10 working days. Phone Gwenda on (01758) 704 000 for details. Some providers of mobile bars will arrange this for you.

Charges: depend on the nature of your function, but these charges are a guide: **A per person charge** of £3.00 for day visitors, and £9.00 / £11.00* for campers or those staying after midnight. **A minimum charge** applies for the barns of £150.00 / £250.00* per night for the camping barn, sometimes reduced in the very low season, and £550.00 / £750.00* for all the barns. A porta-cabin with 1 ladies and 2 gents + 2 urinals is provided, but additional portaloos can be hired at the cost of £30.00 for a weekend (Friday, Saturday) or £45.00 per week plus VAT, with £12.00 per extra empty.
