



## Group information sheet

Groups may be accommodated on the campsite or in one of our special group camping areas, Cae Hendre or the Barn field. We have separate information sheets for groups who want to use the barns, and for Duke of Edinburgh and other youth groups.

**Vehicle access:** There are access tracks around the public campsite and also a number of hard-standings/car parks. Minibuses will be charged at £5.00 each per day if they are taken beyond the main car park. The back of the site, bridge field is reserved for car-free camping. Please use common sense when driving on the grass. Mini-buses and larger vehicles must park on the hard standings and are not allowed on the grass camping areas. You must drive very slowly around the site, a maximum speed of 5 mph (10 kph).

**Conditions apply:** Please read our regulations, available from our website (use the Information button). Camping groups are welcome on these conditions:

- **Group leader:** One member of each group must be our designated contact, collecting fees for the group and maintaining good standards of behaviour.
- **Noise:** We expect quiet from 11.30 pm, and may require a noise bond from groups of up to £20.00 per head, refundable if appropriate noise levels are maintained.
- **Rubbish** must be taken to the main campsite bins, with glass and cans separated for recycling - labeled bins can be provided to help with recycling.
- **Fires** are permitted either on steel firepits that we provide, or on the fire site in Cae Hendre field. Wood can be sold in advance.

**Weather:** Due to its location in the bottom of a mountain valley the campsite can be subject to extreme weather conditions. Very strong winds and torrential rain can occur at any time of year with localised flooding. Please ensure that your camping gear is as robust as possible and correctly erected, and avoid pitching in any obvious dips.

**Boat hire:** We have a selection of kayaks and Canadian canoes for hire. Please arrange hire times and negotiate rates with our warden. Please note that the level and flow of the Afon Glaslyn fluctuates daily due to a hydroelectric power station upstream.

**Charges:** vary with the time of year, see our website for details. We offer discounts for groups only if they are bona fide youth groups, see our youth group information sheet. Otherwise standard camping rates apply.

**Bookings:** If there are more than 20 people in a group, then bookings are required. Download our Group Bookings form from the website, accessed from the Information button. Enclose a deposit and post to the address at the top of the form. A booking does not reserve a place, you are free to find an area which suits your group when you arrive.
