



Group information sheet

Groups may be accommodated on the campsite or in one of our special group camping areas, Cae Hendre or the Barn field. We have separate information sheets for groups who want to use the barns, and for Duke of Edinburgh and other youth groups.

Vehicle access: There are access tracks around the public campsite and also a number of hard-standings/car parks. Minibuses will be charged at £5.00 each per day if they are taken beyond the main car park. The back of the site, bridge field is reserved for car-free camping. Please use common sense when driving on the grass. Mini-buses and larger vehicles must park on the hard standings and are not allowed on the grass camping areas. You must drive very slowly around the site, a maximum speed of 5 mph (10 kph).

Conditions apply: Please read our regulations, available from our website (use the Information button). Camping groups are welcome on these conditions:

- **Group leader:** One member of each group must be our designated contact, collecting fees for the group and maintaining good standards of behaviour.
- **Noise:** We expect quiet from 11.00 pm, 11.30 on wee3kends and may require a noise bond from groups of up to £20.00 per head, refundable if appropriate behaviour is maintained.
- **Rubbish** must be taken to the main campsite bins, with glass and cans separated for recycling - labeled bins can be provided to help with recycling.
- **Fires** are permitted either on steel firepits that we provide, or on the fire site in Cae Hendre field. Wood can be sold in advance.

Weather: Our location in the bottom of a mountain valley means the campsite can have extreme weather including strong winds and torrential rain. Please ensure that your camping gear is as robust as possible and correctly erected, and avoid pitching in any obvious dips.

Activities and boat hire: Group activities including climbing, coasteering, abseiling can all be arranged on site. Kayaks and Canadian canoes are also for hire, @ £5, £8 or £10 per hour with group rates available email us at enquiries@gwynant.com to find out more. Please note the flow of the Afon Glaslyn fluctuates daily due to a hydroelectric power station upstream.

Charges: vary with the time of year, see our website for details. We offer discounts for groups only if they are bone fide youth groups, see our youth group information sheet. Otherwise standard camping rates apply. The child rate is available only to families, not to schools.

Bookings: If there are more than 20 people in a group, then bookings are required. Download our Group Bookings form from the website, accessed from the Information button. Enclose a deposit and post to the address at the top of the form. A booking does not reserve a place, you are free to find an area which suits your group when you arrive.
