Group information sheet

Groups of more than 20 people can use the public campsite if booked in advance, or stay at the barns. We have a separate Barn information sheet as well as one for youth groups.

Vehicle access: There are access tracks around the public campsite and some hard-standings/car parks. Minibuses are charged at £5.00 each per day if taken beyond the main car park. The back of the site, bridge field is reserved for car-free camping. Please use common sense when driving on the grass in cars. Do not take any mini-bus or larger vehicle off the hard standing and these must be parked in a car park. You must drive very slowly around the site, a maximum speed of 5 mph (10 kph).

Conditions apply: Please read our regulations, available from our website (use the Information button). In summary groups are welcome on these conditions:

- **Group leader:** One member must be our designated contact, collecting fees for the group and maintaining good standards of behaviour.
- **Noise:** We expect quiet from 11.00 pm, and may require a noise/behaviour bond from groups, which is £20.00 per head and refundable if all is well. Subsequent visits will not require a bond.
- **Rubbish** must be deposited in the main campsite bins, with glass and cans separated for recycling - labeled bins can be provided to help with recycling.
- **Fires** are permitted on steel firepits at the site, with wood sold each evening.
- **No generators, stereos or music systems** apart from acoustic music played until 11.00 pm.

Weather: Due to its location in the bottom of a mountain valley the campsite can be subject to extreme weather conditions. Very strong winds and torrential rain can occur at any time of year with localised flooding. Please ensure your camping gear is robust and correctly erected, and avoid pitching in obvious dips. Marquees only by arrangement, so long as no heavy vehicles access drive on the grass.

Boat hire and activities: We have single and double kayaks as well as Canadian canoes for hire, and offer discounts for groups hiring more than 6 boats at a time. Please note the level and flow of the Afon Glaslyn fluctuates daily due to a hydroelectric power station upstream. Qualified instructors can be arranged in advance for groups. Adventure activities offered from the site by our instructors include gorge walking in at the Watkin path, or crag hopping and climbing near Lockwood's chimney. Instruction can be arranged for youth groups, by AALA accredited instructors.

Charges: vary with the time of year, see our website for details. We offer discounts for stays of 5 days or more. The youth rate only for bone fide youth groups and those 18 and under, otherwise standard camping rates apply. The child rate is available only to young people with their families.

Bookings: If there are more than 20 people in a group, then bookings are required. Download our Group Bookings form from the website, accessed from the Information button. Enclose a deposit and post to the address at the top of the form. A booking does not reserve a place although you can indicate your preferred field - you can find an area to suit your group when you arrive.
