



Llyn Gwynant Campsite

Booking Terms and Conditions

1. Booking Confirmation

Gwynant Ltd enters into a contract with you when we confirm your booking. When you make the booking, you warrant that you have the authority of all persons in your party to book on their behalf, and will indemnify Gwynant Ltd against all loss and damage arising directly or indirectly, from any act or default by yourself or any person or animal accompanying you. Bookings are not transferable. Please note that camping on Llyn Gwynant Campsite land is restricted to the areas designated, and is not permitted in other areas.

2. Services, Features and Facilities

Some groups on the campsite might use equipment or services provided by a 3rd party, e.g. kayak or canoe instruction, boat hire, raft or bridge building equipment. Gwynant Ltd cannot be responsible for any injury, loss or damage that may result from your using such facilities. As our site is in the natural environment, we cannot accept responsibility for any damage or inconvenience caused by wildlife.

3. Payment

A deposit of 25% of the total cost of your stay or one day's camping fees (whichever is greater) is payable on all advance bookings. The balance is payable when you arrive on site if you are on the main campsite and must be paid two weeks in advance if you are using the barns.

4. Cancellation

If you wish to cancel your booking, notice must be given by email. Provided the cancellation is received not less than seven days before the start date of the holiday, or two weeks in the case of the barns, only the deposit monies will be forfeited.

5. Behaviour

Our campsite is designed for those who enjoy the peace and tranquillity of the natural environment. Good behaviour is required at all times and absolute quiet after 11.00 pm on the main campsite. At the barns loud noise must be reasonable at all times and cease after 12.00pm. No radios are allowed at any time on the main campsite and are restricted to inside the barns. Campfires are only allowed on firepits provided or the campfire site in Cae Hendre, and wood

purchased must be purchased from us. Driving on site must be slow and cars are restricted in some areas. Glass and cans must be separated into the bins provided, and rubbish stowed in closed bags.

Where the site rules are not respected we reserve the right to refuse admission or require a noise bond or to ask members of a group to leave the site at any time, subject to repayment of nights unused. We also reserve the right to refuse entry to the site to caravans over 6 metres in length and commercial vehicles.

6. Amendments

Amendments to your booking can be made up to 14 days before the start of your visit, and are subject to a £10 administration fee. Note that no refunds will be given in the case of adverse weather.

7. Pricing

Prices are subject to change without notice.

8. Arrival and Departure

You can arrive on site from 12 noon to 10pm on your date of arrival. Later arrivals must advise us in advance. If your group is on the main camping site the late arrivals camping area may be used after 10.00pm. This is sited opposite the car park of the public campsite. Where you have made an advance booking, we reserve the right to re-book your space if you do not arrive on the first day of your booking. Group camping areas must be vacated by 12 noon on the day of departure. When pitching, please ensure tents are spaced at least 3m from each other and that you are at least 6 metres away from any other campers not in your group.

9. Minimum Age

We can only accept bookings for parties where there is at least one person aged 18 years or over in the party.

10. Dogs

Dogs are only accepted on condition that they are on a lead at all times and are exercised away from the campsites. Fouling must be collected and disposed of.
