



## D of E and Youth Group Information Sheet

Youth groups including Duke of Edinburgh award groups, scouts and school groups commonly use the campsite, and we offer special concession rates only if the conditions below are met.

**Rates:** For young people who are part of organised groups, we charge just £4.00 per young person, of 18 years or younger, (the child rate is available only to families). Adult teachers pay the normal adult rate. The special youth rate is offered only if these conditions are met:

- **Group leader:** There must be a group leader who collects fees for the whole group. If our wardens have to collect individual fees for youths over 16 then the adult rate applies. A single receipt will be issued to the group.
- **Minibuses** must be kept only in the main car park. Especially early in the season we have had serious damage result from D of E minibuses driving and turning on the grass.
- **Toilet block:** this is not to be used for gatherings, for food preparation or for washing boots, warming feet in the basins or for other inappropriate purposes. Young people must respect other users of the campsite and realize that they are not the only users of our facilities. Food can be prepared in our dishwashing areas if the weather is very bad, but again, other users of our facilities must be respected.
- **Firewood:** if young people want to have campfires, they must remember to bring extra money to buy it. Bags of wood are £4.00 per bag.

Where young people do not meet our youth group conditions we reserve the right to charge them at a normal adult rate.

**Bookings:** If there are more than 20 people in a group, then bookings are required. Download our Group Bookings form from the website, accessed from the Information button. Enclose a deposit and post to the address at the top of the form.

**Barn for inclement weather:** The camping barn can be useful for cooking and shelter when the weather is unkind. See our website Barn link for more or ask our wardens for availability.

**Boat hire and activities:** Activities for groups including canoe instruction, climbing, abseiling and coastering can be arranged by an AALA accredited company which operates from our site, email us at [enquiries@gwynant.com](mailto:enquiries@gwynant.com) for details. Youth groups can also use our boat hire facilities. We also have an orienteering course, see our Activities, and Boat hire pages on our website.
